ENDORSEMENT AND ORDER

Honourable Paul Mayer

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on October 4, 2018, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] On October 2, 2018 the Parties filed a joint letter requesting an adjournment of the oral submissions hearing scheduled for October 30 and 31, 2018. The Parties stated that an adjournment would provide additional time to continue to pursue settlement of the Claim. In a joint letter dated October 4, 2018, the Parties confirmed that they each have a written agreement

to attempt to negotiate settlement of the Claim. The oral submissions hearing scheduled for October 30-31, 2018 is adjourned to **January 15-18, 2019**.

[2] The agreed-upon timeline for filing written submissions has been respected. With the Respondent's agreement, the Claimant has requested an extension to file and serve its Reply submissions. The Claimant's request for a filing extension is granted and Reply submissions shall be filed on or before **December 14, 2018**.

[3] Should the Parties require further assistance from the Tribunal to continue their mediation efforts prior to the hearing, they should write to the Tribunal as soon as possible so arrangements may be made.

THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:

[4] A stay of proceedings is granted until January 14, 2019;

[5] The Parties may contact the Tribunal, if required, to request that the oral submissions hearing be cancelled thirty (30) days prior to the scheduled hearing; and,

[6] A Pre-Hearing Conference will be held by teleconference on **December 18, 2018**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
