A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on March 13, 2018, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa). Also present at the CMC were Chief Ann Louie, Councillor Andrew Meshue, Councillor Chris Wycotte, Councillor Rick Gilbert, Councillor Willie Sellars, and Economic Development Officer Kirk Dressler.

[1] The Parties continue to discuss the matter of costs for the validation phase; however, if they are unable to reach an agreement, the Claimant will need to present a bill of costs to the

Respondent. Should that become necessary, the Tribunal will address this issue with the Parties and may discuss the possibility of mediation.

[2] On or before **April 25, 2018**, the Parties shall provide jointly or separately a letter identifying the issues they agree are before the Tribunal, and those one party or another considers an issue but the other party doesn't. At the next CMC, the Tribunal may wish to discuss the identified issues with the Parties.

[3] At the next CMC, Parties shall be in a position to discuss their intentions in terms of the nature of their expert reports and to report on any steps they have taken to retain any experts.

[4] The next CMC will be held in person in Vancouver on **May 9, 2018** at 10:00 A.M., Pacific Time.
