**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable Harry Slade, Chairperson**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on November 21, 2018, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties shall submit a joint brief to the Tribunal on or before **March 8, 2019**, outlining their progress towards either a negotiated or adjudicated resolution on this matter, including details regarding the steps described below.

[2] The Parties progress pending the next CMC to resolve the question of the definition of the adjoining areas of indeterminate acreage.

[3] The Claimant shall make best efforts to provide the Respondent with general guidance on the approach it anticipates taking regarding the other claims of compensable losses — in particular, identification of the losses and potential methodology for the quantification of damages — on or before **April 4, 2019**.

[4] The Parties shall deliver all expert reports on or before **September 6, 2019**.

[5] A hearing is scheduled for two weeks commencing on **September 23, 2019**, location to be determined. This hearing may be comprised of lay witnesses, expert witnesses, or both.

[6] The Parties shall consult with one another on dates, ideally prior to February 2020, for a final hearing on compensation, and should be prepared to discuss this at the next CMC.

[7] The next CMC will be held in person in Vancouver on **April 15, 2019**, time and location to be determined.
