ENDORSEMENT

A Pre-Hearing Conference was held by teleconference on September 26, 2017, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties reported that an Agreed Statement of Facts has been filed after some initial difficulty.

[2] The Claimants reported that they had jointly filed their written submissions with the Tribunal on September 22, 2017. The Parties expect that all other filings will be made on time as has been directed.

[3] The Parties recommended and the Tribunal agreed that the new documents to be added by the Respondent to the Common Book of Documents (CBD) will be added to the end of the CBD. Consequently, the Claimant's written submissions will not need to be resubmitted with amended references to the CBD.

[4] The Parties advised that only three days will be required for the hearing rather than the five already scheduled. Accordingly, it is directed that the oral submissions hearing for Stage 1 of the Compensation Phase be held for three days commencing **November 21, 2017**, at the Blueberry First Nations Reserve.
