A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on March 20, 2013 at 1:00 P.M. Eastern Time (Ottawa):

[1] The Claimant shall finalize the compilation of documents that will be submitted in support of its claim and file a copy to the Respondent for comments by the end of May 2013.

[2] The Parties shall work amongst themselves toward finalizing a Common Book of Documents by the end of June 2013. In doing so, the Parties shall identify the documents in dispute, if any, and shall make an effort to resolve the issues between themselves.

[3] The Parties shall prepare an Agreed Statement of Facts by the end of September 2013.

[4] The Parties shall continue their work with respect to the experts and the experts' reports. In this regard, the Claimant shall prepare a joint Terms of Reference and file it to the Respondent for comments by the end of August 2013.

[5] The next CMC is tentatively scheduled for September 24, 2013, at 10:00 A.M. Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[6] Before the next CMC, the Parties shall file their briefs, or a joint brief, to the Tribunal indicating the work accomplished since the last CMC, the issues in dispute, if any, and a draft schedule indicating the steps, and the time needed to complete such steps, to move the claim forward.
