ENDORSEMENT

Honourable W.L. Whalen

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on September 1, 2016, at 10:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant reported that the bank records requested by the Respondent in respect of the Claimant’s external accounts no longer existed because the bank only kept records for seven years. However, the Claimant had located audited financial statements for eighteen years that it

would shortly produce. The Respondent will require time to review these statements but expects that they will suffice.

[2] There was general discussion on how the Claim should proceed and there was consensus to discuss it further at the next CMC. Hopefully by that time decisions may have been released on the bring-forward compensation process that would assist the Parties in arriving at a resolution without the necessity of engaging experts to do a full analysis, including testify at a hearing.

[3] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **December 6, 2016**, at 10:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
