A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on September 25, 2014, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties reported that they had reached agreement on the breadth of document production in this proceeding. The Respondent estimates roughly that document research will be complete by the end of April 2015 if all goes well.
