A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on December 5, 2016, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant reported that it had just received its expert's report on December 1, 2016, which it would produce to the Respondent by the end of December 2016, after having had the opportunity to review it.

[2] The Respondent indicated that it had identified a responding expert if one was needed, but that it could not proceed further until such time as the Claimant's expert report had been received and reviewed by the Respondent.

[3] The Claimant reported that a Common Book of Documents was in an advanced state of preparation, subject to documents that might arise from the experts' reports.

[4] The Respondent indicated that it had commenced drafting an Agreed Statement of Facts, which was also dependent on completion of the experts' reports.

[5] The Claimant indicated that its position on bifurcation could not be determined until its expert report had been reviewed.

[6] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **January 31, 2017**, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
