A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on May 2, 2018, at 3:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent withdrew its Application for Bifurcation that was filed with the Tribunal on March 14, 2018.

[2] The Respondent informed the Tribunal that it will not be able to proceed with the expert evidence hearing given that it does not have expert evidence bringing forward the compensation value of historical loss on time for the scheduled hearing of May 22-24, 2018. The expert evidence hearing scheduled for May 22-24, 2018, in Winnipeg, Manitoba is postponed and therefore these dates are vacated.

[3] On or before **May 15, 2018**, the Respondent will write to the Claimant and the Tribunal to confirm the name of the expert it will retain to evaluate compensation as well as the length of time required to complete the expert report.
