A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on May 24, 2018, at 3:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent expects to serve and file its expert report on historical loss to the Claimant by mid-June 2018. Once the Claimant receives the Respondent's expert report, the Claimant will take a few weeks to review the report. The Parties will then estimate the number of hours required for the examination and cross-examination of the two anticipated expert

witnesses, and agree upon the number of days required and proposed dates for the expert evidence hearing. The Parties will then advise the Tribunal of the time required and proposed dates for the hearing by way of a joint letter. If necessary, a CMC may be held to discuss the hearing schedule.

[2] The Respondent expects to file with the Tribunal, with the consent of the Claimant, an application for the examination for discovery of a witness who is an employee of Manitoba Hydro. The Respondent anticipates conducting the examination for discovery over the summer of 2018.

[3] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **July 10, 2018**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
