ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on September 10, 2019, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent will determine whether it will pursue an examination for discovery of a witness from Manitoba Hydro. If so, the Respondent will serve and file its Application for Examination for Discovery on or before **November 1, 2019**.

[2] The Claimant declined an offer to receive the Respondent's proposed questions in advance of receiving the Application, preferring to receive the Application on a prompt schedule.

[3] The Respondent proposed that the examination be in writing, whereas the Claimant preferred oral examination of the witness.

[4] On or before **April 30, 2020**, the Claimant will serve and file its expert reports on injurious affection and compensation models.

[5] On or before **June 1, 2020**, the Respondent will notify the Claimant and the Tribunal as to whether the Respondent intends to prepare an expert report or reports.

[6] The expert evidence hearing will be scheduled once dates for service and filing of all expert reports are known.

[7] At the next CMC, the Parties will be prepared to discuss the Respondent's expected Application for Examination for Discovery. The next CMC will be held during the second week of November 2019 as schedules allow. A further CMC will be held between April 30, 2020 and June 1, 2020, to address the remaining steps required to bring the Claim to a hearing.
