ENDORSEMENT

Honourable Victoria Chiappetta

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on February 3, 2020, at 10:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent indicated that to date, Manitoba Hydro has not found any relevant documents. Counsel for Manitoba Hydro himself has gone through 40 boxes of documents that might have been relevant, but found nothing relevant. Manitoba Hydro will provide a formal letter indicating the results of its document search. The Respondent has asked Manitoba Hydro to

find someone who can speak about whether it was the hydro line in question that connected the reserve to power. The Respondent will include the Claimant in all future discussions with Manitoba Hydro.

[2] The Respondent shall conclude all matters related to Manitoba Hydro on or before **April 30, 2020**. By that time the Respondent must have determined whether Manitoba Hydro has any relevant documents, and whether the hydro line connected the reserve to power.

[3] The Claimant shall file with the Tribunal its expert reports on injurious affection and compensation models on or before **April 30, 2020**.

[4] The Parties shall discuss possible timelines for this Claim, and be prepared to discuss these at the next CMC.

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **May 11, 2020**, at 10:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
