**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable Victoria Chiappetta**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on May 11, 2020, at 10:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] On April 7, 2020, the Respondent advised the Claimant that it dispensed with the interview of the Manitoba Hydro employee and will not be relying on any documents or evidence received directly from Manitoba Hydro.

[2] In its CMC Brief dated May 4, 2020, the Respondent stated that it will not argue that hydropower is a benefit, which can be set off against the compensation owed for the expropriation.

[3] The Respondent is in the process of retaining experts to provide responding reports regarding values of lands and damages associated with the expropriation and present-day valuations.

[4] The COVID-19 pandemic has caused delays for the Respondent in retaining its experts. These delays are expected to last until the late summer.

[5] At the next CMC, the Respondent will inform the Tribunal on the delivery of all expert reports and the Parties will discuss possible timelines for the Claim.

[6] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **October 7, 2020**, at 10:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
