A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on October 7, 2020, at 10:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant reported that its unimproved market value report will be delivered to the Respondent prior to the next CMC and as quickly as possible hitherto.

[2] At the next CMC, the Claimant shall provide details on the status of its land damages report.

[3] The Respondent reported that it is still in the process of retaining experts to provide responding reports regarding values of lands and damages associated with the expropriation and present-day valuations, but expects that these reports will be completed within three months' time after receipt of the Claimant's reports.

[4] At the next CMC, the Respondent shall provide a status update on the process and timing for retaining experts and timelines for completion of expert reports.

[5] The Respondent requested an amendment to the style of cause to be amended to "as represented by the Minister of Crown-Indigenous Relations".

[6] Pursuant to section 2 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Act*, SC 2008, c 22, the style of cause shall be changed to "as represented by the Minister of Crown-Indigenous Relations", to reflect the change to the Minister's name.

[7] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **January 5, 2021**, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
