**ENDORSEMENT**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on October 11, 2017, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant shall provide a draft Agreed Statement of Facts to the Respondent on or before **November 1, 2017**, in order for the Parties to continue working towards finalizing an Agreed Statement of Facts which shall be filed with the Tribunal on or before **December 1, 2017**. If the Parties are unable to come to an agreement on the contents of an Agreed Statement

of Facts, the Parties shall notify the Tribunal and a CMC will be scheduled on the first available date after December 1, 2017.

[2] The Claimant shall provide a proposed Common Book of Documents to the Respondent on or before **January 15, 2018**. The Parties shall file with the Tribunal a Common Book of Documents on or before **February 15, 2018** unless they are unable to agree on the contents of it, in which case they will notify the Tribunal and a CMC will be scheduled on the first available date after February 15, 2018.

[3] A hearing is to be scheduled for May or June 2018. The Parties shall discuss and inform the Registry of possible hearing dates and venue, as well as the number of experts or lay witnesses, if any. The Tribunal suggests holding the hearing on or near the reserve if possible.
