ENDORSEMENT AND ORDER

Honourable William Grist

FURTHER to the Joint Application of the Parties filed with the Tribunal on March 27, 2019, in which they request a stay of proceedings pending several issues arising out of the potential participation of Alberta in negotiations for a land transfer in settlement of the Claim;

AND FURTHER to a Case Management Conference (CMC) held by teleconference on April 18, 2019, at 1:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa);

THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:

- [1] A stay of proceedings is granted until the next CMC;
- [2] The next CMC shall be scheduled as soon as it is convenient after June 15, 2019;
- [3] Prior to the next CMC, the Parties shall file a draft Consent Order settling the question of how many individuals were unaccounted for in calculating the amount of reserve land the Claimant was given under treaty; and,
- [4] In their CMC Briefs for the next CMC, the Parties shall provide the following information:
 - a. a description of the negotiations to date;
 - b. progress on Alberta's participation in the negotiations for a land transfer;
 - c. any scheduled negotiations involving Alberta; and,
 - d. the Parties' positions on mediation, including on Tribunal mediation.
