ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held in Edmonton, Alberta on September 6, 2013 at 11:30 A.M., Mountain Time (Edmonton).

[1] The Parties shall consider the possibility of bringing a preliminary issue forward.

[2] The Parties shall provide a joint progress report on or before November 29, 2013. The joint progress report shall include:

- a) document inquiries;
- b) investigations;
- c) the status of document lists;
- d) a description of any further documentary investigations the Parties respectively consider necessary;
- e) a statement as to whether the documentary record is adequate as of November 29, 2013;
- f) whether either Party anticipates retaining experts, and in the affirmative, identify the general areas which the experts will be asked to canvass;
- g) whether there has been any communication relating to identifying and framing preliminary issues having regard for observations made by the Honourable Harry Slade.

[3] The Parties shall commence work on an Agreed Statement of Facts.

[4] A further CMC will be held after November 29, 2013.

[5] The Parties shall advise the Registry if they require a CMC at any time before the joint progress report comes due on or before November 29, 2013.

[6] The Parties shall communicate their availability for a further CMC after November 29, 2013 at their earliest convenience.
