A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on February 27, 2018, at 2:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties shall file their Agreed Statement of Facts and Agreed Statement of Issues with the Tribunal on or before **April 3, 2018**.

[2] The Respondent shall file its expert report with the Tribunal on or before **August 17, 2018**.

[3] The Parties shall finalize the Oral History Protocol on or before **April 16, 2018**.

[4] The Claimant shall serve its Will-Say Statements on the Respondent on or before **May 1, 2018**. The Respondent shall provide any preliminary objections to the Claimant on the Will-Say Statements on or before **May 15, 2018**.

[5] The Parties shall discuss and agree upon dates for an oral history evidence hearing and a site visit which will be held before August 17, 2018. The hearing will commence on a Tuesday and is expected to take place for 2 days.

[6] The expert evidence and oral submissions hearing shall be heard together in the community on dates to be set between October 23, 2018 and November 30, 2018. The hearing is expected to take place for 2-3 days.

[7] At the next CMC, the Parties shall be prepared to discuss Notices pursuant to section 22 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Act*.

[8] The Parties will coordinate with the Registry the date and time for the next CMC which is to be held by teleconference in June 2018.
