ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference was held by teleconference on June 7, 2018, at 1:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant filed its Further Amended Declaration on June 5, 2018. The Respondent shall file its Further Amended Response on or before **July 18, 2018**.

[2] The Respondent is working on an expert report on the issue related to the Secretary of State for the Colonies. The Respondent hopes that it will still be able to file the report with the Tribunal by August 18, 2018.

[3] The Tribunal noted that further supplementation of the evidence filed on this Claim may be required. The Parties discussed the issue of how to deal with the findings of fact made in *?Akisq'nuk First Nation v Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada*, 2016 SCTC 3 (the 2016 SCT Decision).

[4] The Respondent suggested that the Claimant could add to the Agreed Statement of Facts factual information from the 2016 SCT Decision, and the Respondent would review such additions and determine which of them the Respondent could agree to.

[5] The Claimant asked if the Tribunal could assist the Parties by mediating which of the findings of fact in the 2016 SCT Decision would be admitted by the Respondent.

[6] This matter will be further discussed during the oral history evidence hearing to be held June 12-15, 2018, in Windermere, British Columbia.

[7] Timelines for the filing of Memoranda of Fact and Law prior to the hearing scheduled for November 6-9, 2018, will be discussed at a later CMC.

[8] A Notice pursuant to section 22 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Act* shall be sent to the Shuswap Indian Band and ?Aq'am.

[9] A Notice pursuant to section 22 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Act* was sent to the Province of British Columbia on November 5, 2013.
