1. Pursuant to Rule 30, the Claimants make application for leave to file a Notice of Application under Rule 31 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Rules of Practice and Procedure* questioning whether the Tribunal should admit the documents and transcripts provided by Standing Buffalo Dakota First Nation. Standing Buffalo Dakota First Nation requests determination that the documents do not attract settlement privilege. Standing Buffalo Dakota First Nation also submits that the Tribunal should determine whether the Elders' evidence as part of the National Energy Board Tribunal proceeding should be admitted as part of these proceedings given they are necessary, relevant and reliable and the evidence is not otherwise available given the Elders who provided the oral traditional evidence are now deceased and the evidence is not otherwise available.
