**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable W.L. Whalen**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on July 6, 2018 at 12:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent reported that it had conducted further research in aid of responding to written interrogatories, with the result that it had identified 20 to 30 more documents, copies of which it would provide to the Claimants in the next few days. It will deliver its sworn response to written interrogatories on or before **July 31, 2018** and hopefully sooner. The Respondent does not know the identity of the individual who will swear the response to written interrogatories although it indicated which department of government that individual was likely associated with.

[2] In a joint letter filed on July 12, 2018, all Parties agreed that the **September 17-21, 2018** hearing should be rescheduled for three consecutive days from **October 10-12, 2018**.

[3] The hearing will be held **October 10-12, 2018**, at a location to be determined.

[4] Given this, the Tribunal has extended the time to file hearing materials. The Parties must file documents to meet the following filing deadlines:

- Common Book of Documents August 28, 2018
- Agreed Statement of Issues and Facts August 28, 2018

- Claimants' Written Submissions of Fact and Law      September 18, 2018
- Respondent's Written Submissions of Fact and Law      September 28, 2018
- Claimants' Written Submissions in Reply      October 5, 2018

[5]      The Parties were requested to prepare and file a Joint Book of Authorities.

[6]      The Pre-hearing Conference originally scheduled by teleconference on **September 5, 2018**, at 12:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa) will be rescheduled for a date in early October 2018 to be coordinated by the Registry.
