ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on May 18, 2018, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant reported that it had today delivered its expert loss of use report to the Respondent. The Respondent requires time to review the report and consider whether a responding report will be required and whether a bifurcation application should be made before the Respondent retains a responding expert.

[2] The Respondent confirmed that its expert, Mr. Love, had responded to the Claimant's expert's Phase 1 and 2 reports. The Claimant indicated that it would not reply to these responding reports. The Respondent expects to receive Mr. Love's responding expert report in respect of the Claimant's Phase 3 expert report on or before May 31, 2018 and to file and serve a copy of that report to the Respondent on or before June 15, 2018. The Claimant will then consider whether it needs a Phase 3 reply report.

[3] The necessity and scheduling of an application for bifurcation and a separate expert evidence hearing will be considered at the next CMC.

[4] The Parties continue to work cooperatively on an Agreed Statement of Issues, an Agreed Statement of Facts and a Common Book of Documents, which cannot be completed until the expert reports are complete.

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **July 5, 2018**, at 12:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
