

evidence that leave her report incomplete. The Respondent's expert has reviewed the report and agrees that those gaps exist and that it would be important to fill them, if possible. It appears that these gaps consist of pay lists that the Claimant's expert was not permitted access to. These documents may exist with the Province of Alberta. It is not clear whether the Province's privacy legislation would prevent access to these documents.

[2] Counsel for the Parties agreed to consult with their respective experts and each other in identifying whether and where the restricted documents may exist and how to access them. Because of privacy protection, a court order may be necessary to obtain release. These questions will be addressed at the next CMC together with the timing of updating the Claimant's expert's report. The Respondent indicated that a responding expert report will likely be necessary but that its expert cannot commence work until sometime in September 2018 because of other commitments.

[3] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **July 5, 2018**, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
