ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on June 21, 2018, at 1:20 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties consent to the following schedule:

- a. The Respondent will serve and file a Responding Expert Surveyor Report on or before **July 31, 2018**;

- b. The Claimant will serve and file its Responding Expert Handwriting Report and/or Supplementary/Reply Expert Surveyor Report on or before **December 30, 2018**;
- c. The Claimant will serve and file its Expert Valuation Report and Historical Report on Valuation Issues on or before **December 30, 2018**;
- d. The Respondent will serve and file its Responding Expert Valuation Report on or before **June 30, 2019**, with a status report to be filed on or before **April 30, 2019**;
- e. The Claimant will serve and file its Supplementary/Reply Valuation Report on or before **August 30, 2019**, with a status report to be filed on or before **June 30, 2019**; and,
- f. The Parties will finalize and file the Common Book of Documents on or before **September 30, 2019**.

[2] The Claimant reported that it intends to call oral history testimony. An oral history evidence hearing will be held after the next CMC but before September 30, 2019. The Claimant is at liberty to apply for a later date if prejudiced by that date.

[3] The Claimant suggested the following locations for the hearings: the oral history hearing in Metlakatla, the expert hearing occur in Vancouver, and the oral submissions hearing in Metlakatla.

[4] The Parties will consider their positions on bifurcation and any terms of a possible bifurcation. If the Parties reach agreement on bifurcation, they will advise the Tribunal.

[5] The following items will be discussed at the next CMC:

- a. bifurcation;
- b. the Claimant shall provide the number and the names of oral history witnesses; and,
- c. dates for the oral history evidence hearing, expert evidence hearing and oral submissions hearing.

[6] The Parties shall be in contact with the Registry to schedule the next CMC on a date as soon as it can be arranged subsequent to December 30, 2018.
