**ENDORSEMENT AND ORDER**

**Honourable William Grist**

**FURTHER** to a Case Management Conference (CMC) held by teleconference on May 28, 2018, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa):

[1] The Claimant has agreed to proceed to negotiate compensation with the Respondent in this Claim.

[2] The Parties will attempt to reach agreement on a consent order disposing of the validity issue on or before June 27, 2018, or advise the Tribunal in writing if they have not been able to do so.

[3] Further to the Direction dated May 7, 2018, the Parties expect to finalize and file the Agreed Statement of Facts with the Tribunal on or before **June 1, 2018**.

[4] The Parties will prepare a Negotiation Protocol and work plan to be filed with the Tribunal.

[5] The Claimant indicated that it is developing Terms of Reference for an expert appraisal report. The report will be in evidentiary form so that it can be used in a Tribunal proceeding if negotiations are unsuccessful.

[6] The Tribunal indicated that it can provide mediation to assist the parties in negotiations.

**THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:**

[7] A stay of proceedings is granted until November 28, 2018, to allow Parties to negotiate a settlement on compensation.

[8] The Parties shall contact the Tribunal to schedule a CMC to report on progress in negotiations at a time convenient after November 28, 2018.
