[1] The Parties shall file a Joint Report (or individual Reports, if they cannot agree) regarding the progression of document production, the status and delivery of Will-Say statements

(including any issues relating to the adequacy of said statements), and the status of an Agreed Statement of Issues on or before December 17, 2014.

[2] The Claimant shall report the anticipated time of delivery of its Expert Report on or before December 17, 2014.

[3] The Claimant shall confirm whether or not the elders will experience any discomfort proceeding with the hearing at the St. Eugene Golf Resort and Casino (the former St. Eugene Indian Residential School) on or before December 17, 2014.

[4] The Parties shall contact the Tribunal regarding possible dates in early 2015 for a hearing of *viva voce* evidence.

[5] The Parties shall contact the Tribunal if a CMC is required before the end of the year.
