NOTICE OF APPLICATION ON CONSENT

Pursuant to Rules 5, 11, 31 and 34 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Rules of Practice and Procedure*, this Notice of Application on Consent for an adjournment is filed by the Parties seeking the following Order:

1. To adjourn the Expert Hearing scheduled to proceed June 13, 2017, to a date 60 days after the Parties advise this Honourable Tribunal of their intention to resume the Expert Hearing, but not later than June 1, 2018, without further consent of the Parties and direction of the Tribunal; and,
2. For the matter to remain a specially managed proceeding in accordance with the powers of the Case Management Judge as prescribed by Part 7 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Rules of Practice and Procedure* and Rule 385 of the *Federal Court Rules*.

THE GROUNDS FOR THE APPLICATION ARE:

1. The parties have agreed to pursue a negotiated settlement and to adjourn the Expert Hearing and any further steps in the conduct of this Hearing pending the outcome of the settlement negotiations; and
2. In order to facilitate these negotiations and increase the prospect of success, the Parties have agreed to request the continuation of case management of this matter, notwithstanding the adjournment, with the role of the Case Management Judge to rule in a summary manner on any disputes that may arise between the parties in the course of settlement negotiations.

2. Consent of all Parties.
