A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on December 14, 2017, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent wishes to introduce 23 documents to the Common Book of Documents that the Claimant has contested. The Claimant is awaiting specific instructions from its client

regarding the introduction of the 23 documents. This issue will be resolved on or before **February 12, 2018**.

[2] The Parties reported that an oral history evidence hearing and an expert evidence hearing are not required in this Claim. The Parties wish to proceed to the validity phase of the Claim.

[3] The hearing on oral submissions is scheduled for **May 8-10, 2018** to be held in the Claimant's community.

[4] The expert reports filed with the Tribunal will be considered as evidence. Because the results of these reports are fairly congruent, the Parties do not seek to call the experts as witnesses. On or before **January 15, 2018**, the Parties shall file with the Tribunal a joint letter waiving their right to the exact wording of Rule 93 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Rules of Practice and Procedure*, SOR/2011-119, and to cross-examine the opposing Party's expert.

[5] The Claimant shall file with the Tribunal its Memorandum of Fact and Law on or before **March 9, 2018**. The Respondent shall file with the Tribunal its Memorandum of Fact and Law on or before **April 9, 2018**. The Claimant shall file with the Tribunal its Reply, if required, on or before **April 23, 2018**.

[6] The Parties are encouraged to consider the option of Tribunal-assisted mediation with their clients which will be discussed at the next CMC.

[7] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **February 19, 2018**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa). A date for a Pre-Hearing Conference will be scheduled at this CMC.
