ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on May 25, 2018, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant reported that it received the Respondent’s expert’s responding report on March 22, 2018. The Claimant’s expert has reviewed the report and will be delivering a responding report dealing with areas of disagreement and concern. He expects to deliver the report on or before **June 15, 2018**.

[2] The Parties then indicated that they hope to have their experts discuss areas of differences with a view to reconciling all or some. Then the Parties will also consider whether it will be necessary to retain a joint or separate economist. The Tribunal offered mediation. The next steps will be reviewed at the next CMC, including whether there should be a separate expert evidence hearing.

[3] The Parties confirmed that it will not be possible to complete an Agreed Statement of Facts, an Agreed Statement of Issues and a Common Book of Documents until the expert reports are completed.

[4] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **July 5, 2018**, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
