A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on January 7, 2019, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant advised that it has provided a settlement proposal to the Respondent on December 10, 2018. The Respondent indicated that it needs time to review it and obtain instructions.
