**ENDORSEMENT**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on March 6, 2018, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant shall provide the Respondent with the remaining documents in its possession on or before **March 15, 2018**.

[2] The Parties reported that they had discussed the jurisdictional issue raised at the last CMC, but will not be able to address it until they both have the Claimant's forensic accounting report in hand.

[3] The Claimant expects to serve and file its forensic accounting report in early April 2018.

[4] The Claimant shall serve and file its expert appraisal report on or before **March 15, 2018**. The Respondent anticipates that it will receive its responding appraisal report from its expert by the end of May and if so, expects to be in a position to serve and file its responding report by mid-June 2018.

[5] The Claimant expects that it will be able to serve and file its historical report on or before **June 29, 2018**. The Respondent will need to review the Claimant's historical report before setting a filing deadline for its responding report.

[6] Prior to the next CMC, the Parties will prepare a joint draft plan of proceeding for the remaining steps to bring the proceedings to the expert evidence hearing, and will file the joint draft plan of proceeding with their CMC briefs.

[7] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **June 27, 2018**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
