**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable Harry Slade, Chairperson**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held in person on July 19, 2018, at 10:00 A.M., at Charest Reporting, 885 West Georgia Street, Vancouver (Pacific Time).

[1] The Claimant shall confirm its witness list for the upcoming oral history evidence hearing, and provide the Respondent with Will-Say Statements, on or before **July 27, 2018**. The

Claimant shall also advise both the Respondent and the Tribunal as soon as possible whether or not the planned site visit is going to be feasible.

[2] The Respondent shall advise the Claimant and the Tribunal on or before **July 31, 2018** whether interim, without prejudice, resolution of the issues raised in the Claimant's Application for Costs, filed July 18, 2018, on the basis discussed at the CMC is possible.

[3] The Parties will advise whether they consent to another Member of the Tribunal hearing the Claimant's Application for Costs.

[4] The Claimant has retained two experts currently, Rod Cook and Gordon Gislason. The Claimant shall serve and file Mr. Gislason's primary report on or before **October 31, 2018**, and shall serve and file Mr. Cook's primary report on or before **December 14, 2018**.

[5] The Respondent shall inquire with its prospective expert, John Peebles, as to whether he is able to begin work on a primary report immediately, and advise the Claimant and the Tribunal.

[6] The next CMC is to be held in-person in the Claimant's community at the conclusion of the oral history evidence hearing which is scheduled for the **week of September 10, 2018**. At this CMC, the Parties will advise if they have been able to reach a without prejudice interim agreement on costs.
