ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on November 16, 2017, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties have not been able to reach an agreement on a Site Visit Protocol and welcomed guidance from the Tribunal.

[2] At the oral history evidence hearing, the Parties will provide a map of the claim area tide tables. Elder Daniel Billy will mark the map while in the hearing.

[3] The Claimant will be providing a minibus to provide transportation to all parties for the site visit at Rebecca Spit.

[4] Spectators, including members of the First Nations community, are permitted to attend the site visit and view the Court process with the understanding that they will not participate in the process.

[5] The oral history evidence hearing will begin at 9:30 a.m. on Tuesday December 5. Mr. Billy will testify.

[6] The site visit will take place after the examination in-chief and any questioning of Mr. Billy. It is anticipated that at the site visit, Mr. Billy will indicate locations that he marked on the map earlier in the hearing room. The Tribunal may have questions for Mr. Billy at the site visit.

[7] During the site visit, Counsel for both Parties may make note of any concerns or questions they may have regarding statements made by Mr. Billy.

[8] After the site visit, the hearing will, if necessary, be reconvened in the hearing room. If necessary, Mr. Billy will restate anything stated on the site visit for the purposes of the record. At this time, Counsel for both Parties may raise any concerns with the Tribunal and ask Mr. Billy any further questions for the purposes of the record.

[9] In advance of the hearing, Counsel for the Claimant will advise the Registry as to whether there will be an opening ceremony.
