**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable Paul Mayer**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on November 23, 2017, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties indicated that they are in the process of selecting a joint survey expert. The Parties will ask the expert whether the work can be completed in winter. On or before **December 27, 2017**, the Parties will file with the Tribunal a joint brief indicating the date by which the joint

expert report will be completed. After December 27, 2017, the Registry will contact the Parties to schedule the next CMC.

[2] The Respondent produced 200 new documents for the Common Book of Documents on November 6, 2017. The Claimant will respond to the Respondent regarding the Common Book of Documents on or before **January 16, 2018**.

[3] The Parties will finalize the Common Book of Documents and work on the Agreed Statement of Facts once the joint expert report has been completed.

[4] The Respondent indicated that once the joint expert report has been completed, it is possible that the Claim can be resolved without a hearing. Both Parties are open to mediation of the Claim.
