ENDORSEMENT

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on October 16, 2017, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The expert evidence hearing remains on schedule to be held in Regina or Saskatoon during the week of **February 5, 2018**. The Parties confirmed that they will only require 3 days for the expert evidence hearing and that they will meet the Joint Proposed Plan of Proceeding deadline for the service and filing of responding expert reports, being on or before **December 15**,

2017. The Parties are to advise whether reply expert reports are necessary on or before **December 29, 2017.** Reply reports, if necessary, are to be served and filed on or before **January 15, 2018.**

[2] The hearing in February may be extended to include the entire week to allow for the oral history evidence hearing should the Claimant be in a position to hold this hearing at this time. The Claimant may be able to provide a final number of expected Elder or community witnesses at the next CMC. The timeline for the oral history evidence hearing will be discussed at the next CMC.

[3] The Parties agreed to bifurcate the Claim's hearing into validity and compensation stages and will provide the Tribunal with a draft Order shortly. The Tribunal undertook to provide the Parties with an updated Bifurcation Order template for their consideration.

[4] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **December 12, 2017,** at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
