A Case Management Conference was held by teleconference on January 8, 2019, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Respondent advised that it is currently reviewing the draft of Hal Love’s expert reply report, and shall serve and file it with the Tribunal on or before **February 7, 2019**.

[2] The Respondent will provide its proposed changes, if any, to the Agreed Statement of Facts and Agreed Statement of Issues as soon as is practicable following the service of the above-noted report.

[3] The Claimant is awaiting receipt of the Hal Love Report to determine whether a further reply report will be required, and in order to finalize its work on the Common Book of Documents.

[4] The Claimant confirmed that one elder from the community is expected to provide oral history testimony at the oral history and expert evidence hearing scheduled for May 7-10, 2019 and that all the necessary preparations for that testimony, such as exchange of a Will-Say Statement and establishment of an Oral History Protocol, are complete.

[5] The Respondent is to confirm that its expert witness, Hal Love, is available for the May 2019 hearing.

[6] The Parties will be prepared to discuss all matters related to the hearing, as outlined in Rule 56 of the *Specific Claims Tribunal Rules of Practice and Procedure*, at the Pre-Hearing Conference, which is to be held by teleconference on **April 2, 2019**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
