A Case Management Conference was held by teleconference on April 25, 2019, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties reported that their experts had reached substantial agreement and requested an adjournment of the oral history and expert evidence hearing in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, scheduled for May 6-10, 2019. The hearing dates of May 6-10, 2019, are vacated.

[2] The Parties requested Tribunal mediation in lieu of the oral history and expert evidence hearing, and agreed that the Honourable Paul Mayer could preside over the mediation.

[3] The Parties tentatively agreed to schedule the mediation for the days of May 6 and 7, 2019, in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, conditional upon client approval and attendance issues.
