A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on April 12, 2017, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Tribunal grants leave for the Claimant to file its Application to seek to admit affidavit statements of deceased persons, including one unsworn affidavit. The Claimant shall serve and file its Application on or before **May 5, 2017**.

[2] Considering the consent of the Claimant, the Respondent shall serve and file its Response to the Application on or before **June 5, 2017**.

[3] The hearing on the Application will be heard by teleconference on **July 12, 2017**, at 11:00 A.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[4] The Respondent shall provide a draft Common Book of Documents to the Claimant on or before **May 5, 2017**. The Claimant shall respond to the draft Common Book of Documents on or before **June 15, 2017**.

[5] The Claimant shall provide a draft Agreed Statement of Facts and Agreed Statement of Issues to the Respondent on or before **May 1, 2017**. The Respondent shall respond to the draft Agreed Statement of Facts and Agreed Statement of Issues on or before **May 31, 2017**, (depending on the length of these documents).

[6] The Claimant had provided a Will-Say Statement of Elder Urbin Louison to the Respondent on February 17, 2017. The Claimant does not intend to call any other witnesses for the oral history evidence hearing. The Parties shall discuss possible dates for the oral history evidence hearing and whether this will be combined with the expert evidence hearing and shall report back to the Tribunal at the next CMC (yet to be scheduled).

[7] The Parties anticipate not requiring another CMC until possibly sometime in the Fall or once the expert reports of the Claimant are completed and the Respondent has had sufficient time to review them and decide whether it will require a response report. The date for the next CMC may be revisited at the hearing of the Application on July 12, 2017.
