**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable William Grist**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on March 26, 2019, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties agreed on the substance of a draft Consent Order on the validity of the Claim. The Tribunal shall issue a substantively identical Order on validity.

[2] The Parties jointly requested a stay of proceedings to negotiate on compensation. The Tribunal shall grant a stay of proceedings until September 30, 2019, conditional upon two matters: that the Parties resubmit their draft Order on a stay of proceedings in the Claim on or before **April 15, 2019**, and that the Parties submit the materials required by Practice Direction #15, paragraph 2, on or before **July 2, 2019**.

[3] Upon receipt of the Parties' materials required by Practice Direction #15, paragraph 2, the Tribunal shall determine whether a CMC is required to discuss those materials, and shall direct the Registry accordingly.

[4] If a CMC is not required after the Parties submit the materials required by Practice Direction #15, paragraph 2, the Registry shall contact the Parties to schedule the next CMC, which is to take place as soon as possible after September 30, 2019.
