ENDORSEMENT AND ORDER

Honourable William Grist

WHEREAS at the Case Management Conference (CMC) held on March 26, 2019, the Parties applied for a stay of proceedings in order to negotiate a settlement on compensation for this Claim;

AND WHEREAS the Parties' joint CMC brief filed with the Tribunal on March 19, 2019, contains information regarding the filing of a draft Consent Order and a draft Endorsement and Order for a stay of proceedings;

THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:

[1] A stay of proceedings is granted until September 30, 2019;

[2] The Parties shall file, by joint brief or separate briefs, on or before **July 2, 2019**, an update with the Tribunal with respect to the progress of negotiations, to include the following information as required by Practice Direction #15:

- a. A copy of the written agreement to enter into negotiations;
- b. Whether without prejudice settlement offers have been made and responded to, with dates;
- c. Whether the Parties have agreed upon the basis for compensation;
- d. Whether additional expert reports, separate or joint, have been commissioned or obtained since the filing of the Parties' joint CMC brief on March 19, 2019, including a description of subject matter and dates, and whether any such additional reports have been prepared in a format suitable for the Tribunal in the event that negotiations are unsuccessful;
- e. Whether there are any areas of disagreement on which the Parties would be open to mediation by the Tribunal;
- f. A list of any remaining contentious issues; and,
- g. A summary of the measures presently planned to advance the negotiation during the period for which the proposed stay remains in effect, including the schedule of meeting dates and agreed dates, if any, for presentation of offers and counter-offers.

[3] If the Parties wish to seek an extension of the stay of proceedings beyond September 30, 2019, another CMC will be held as soon as convenient following the expiry of the above stay on September 30, 2019.
