ORDER

FURTHER to the Parties’ Joint Case Management Conference (CMC) Brief filed with the Tribunal on August 14, 2019, in which they request a further six month extension of the stay of proceedings to continue without prejudice settlement discussions on compensation;

THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:

[1] The CMC scheduled for September 11, 2019 is adjourned;

[2] The stay of proceedings is extended for six months, namely from September 30, 2019 to March 31, 2020;

[3] The Parties shall file, by joint or separate briefs, on or before **March 31, 2020**, an update with the Tribunal indicating:

- a. the progress of negotiations; and,
- b. whether the Parties wish to seek another extension of the stay of proceedings beyond March 31, 2020, and if so, their reasons in accordance with Practice Direction #15.

[4] The next CMC will be held as soon as convenient following the expiry of the above stay on March 31, 2020.
