A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on November 28, 2018, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Claimant intends to rely on three expert reports: two by Mr. Dewhirst and one by Dr. Galois.

[2] The Respondent now has a contract in place for an expert to respond to Mr. Dewhirst's first report.

[3] The Respondent is seeking client instructions as to whether it will need to retain a second expert (an archaeologist) to review and respond to Mr. Dewhirst's supplemental report, which contains archaeological evidence. The Respondent will indicate at the next CMC whether it has identified a second expert, and whether a contract is in place.

[4] The Claimant intends to provide to the Respondent an Amended List of Documents, including aerial photographs and topographical maps, on or before **December 14, 2018**.

[5] The Respondent intends to provide a revised draft Agreed Statement of Facts and revised draft Agreed Statement of Issues to the Claimant on or before **January 18, 2019**.

[6] The Parties shall contact the Registry to schedule a CMC as soon after **February 1, 2019**, as is convenient for the schedules of the Parties and the Tribunal.
