A Case Management Conference was held by teleconference on January 16, 2019, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The oral history evidence hearing scheduled for April 8–12, 2019, is rescheduled for April 30–May 3, 2019. The hearing will be held in Ahousaht, British Columbia.

[2] The Claimant shall file its Amended Declaration of Claim with the Tribunal on or before **February 15, 2019**.

[3] The final Amended Will-Say Statements for the witnesses at the oral history evidence hearing will be filed with the Tribunal on or before **March 1, 2019**.

[4] The Claimant wishes to hire an expert to do additional research regarding the lands around its reserve. This research will commence after April 1, 2019, in the new fiscal year, when the Claimant has been given new funding.

[5] Once the new expert report of the Claimant is available, the Respondent wishes to determine whether additional research or a responding expert report will be needed.
