**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable Paul Mayer**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on March 28, 2018, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties will apply for a stay of proceedings by providing the Tribunal with the following information:

- i. A summary of the measures presently planned to advance the negotiation during the period for which the proposed stay remains in effect including:
  - a. Agreed dates for delivery of expert reports, if any;
  - b. A schedule of meeting dates;
  - c. Agreed dates, if any, for presentation of offers and counter-offers; and,
  - d. Whether either or both Parties seek Tribunal-assisted mediation.

[2] Once the Parties have provided the Tribunal with the above information, a CMC will be held to discuss the request. Having heard the Parties, the Tribunal, will grant the stay of proceedings if in its opinion, in light of the Tribunal's concern for proportionality and the just and timely resolution of claims, and based on the workplan submitted, the stay will facilitate the resolution of the Claim through negotiations within a reasonable period of time. If granted, the stay will be granted for an initial period of 6 months.

[3] The workplan pursuant to paragraph 3 of the Tribunal's Endorsement dated February 9, 2018 is no longer required.

[4] A Bifurcation Order is no longer required.

[5] The next CMC will be held by teleconference on **April 30, 2018**, at 4:30 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).
