ORDER

Honourable William Grist

UPON THE JOINT REQUEST of the Parties by letter dated July 24, 2018, to request an order granting a stay of proceedings, for a period of six months, to allow the Parties to pursue a negotiated settlement;

AND CONSIDERING the Tribunal’s concern for proportionality and the just and timely resolution of the Claim;

THE TRIBUNAL ORDERS THAT:

[1] The Case Management Conference (CMC) scheduled for July 24, 2018 is adjourned;

[2] A stay of proceedings is granted until **January 25, 2019**;

[3] The Parties shall advise the Tribunal, in writing, of the following on or before **November 15, 2018**: their progress towards negotiating a settlement in respect of this Claim (including a copy of any negotiation agreement protocol which has been agreed to by the Parties) as well as available dates for an oral history evidence hearing, to be held if necessary as soon as possible after the end of the six-month period;

[4] Either Party to this Claim may reactivate this Claim upon thirty (30) days' written notice to the opposing Party and to the Tribunal; and,

[5] The Parties shall contact the Registry to schedule the next CMC to be held on the soonest possible date following the end of the six month stay period.
