**ENDORSEMENT**

A first Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on March 8, 2019, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties reported that they are close to agreeing on a draft Consent Order on the validity of the Claim. The Parties agreed to finalize the draft Consent Order and file it with the Tribunal before the next CMC.

[2] The Parties reported that, once the draft Consent Order is finalized, they intend to file a Joint Application for a stay of proceedings in accordance with Practice Direction # 15, to allow them to negotiate on compensation for the Claim. They shall file their Joint Application for a stay of proceedings at the same time as they file the draft Consent Order.

[3] The Tribunal shall consider the draft Consent Order and the Joint Application for a stay of proceedings at the next CMC, which shall be convened as soon after **May 1, 2019**, as is practicable. The Registry shall contact the Parties to schedule the date and time of the next CMC.
