ENDORSEMENT

Honourable William Grist

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on April 22, 2020, at 3:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The stay of proceedings expires May 1, 2020. The Claimant reported frustration with the progress of negotiations and prefers to return to preparing for the compensation hearing. The Respondent did not oppose this proposal.

[2] The Claimant expects its expert appraisal report will be completed on or before July 1, 2020. The Claimant will report to the Tribunal prior to July 1, 2020, if this deadline proves unfeasible.

[3] The Claimant is pursuing expertise relating to economic losses, including timber losses and possibly fisheries losses.

[4] The Respondent will determine whether it will file with the Tribunal a response report to the Claimant's appraisal report on or before July 15, 2020.

[5] The Parties are asked to consider the viability of holding the expert evidence hearing and oral submissions hearing together, either in person or by videoconference, in late fall 2020. The Claimant does not yet know its preferred location, if the hearing or hearings are held in person.

[6] The next CMC will be held by teleconference as soon as the Parties' schedules allow after July 15, 2020. The Registry will contact the Parties to schedule the date and time of the next CMC.
