**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable Harry Slade, Chairperson**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on April 10, 2019, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties agreed to the bifurcation of this Claim and filed a draft Bifurcation Order with the Tribunal. The Tribunal issued the Bifurcation Order on April 11, 2019.

[2] The Parties agreed to schedule a site visit, an oral history evidence hearing and an Early Case Planning CMC the week of June 10-14, 2019 in Kanaka Bar, British Columbia. The Claimant has since filed a letter with the Tribunal advising that it is not available that week, but is available the week of June 24, 2019. The Respondent shall advise the Tribunal if it is available that week. If it is not, the Registry will schedule a CMC to set a new date for the site visit, oral history evidence hearing and Early Case Planning CMC.

[3] The Parties agreed to work together to develop a Site Visit Protocol and an Oral History Protocol, including a schedule to disclose Will-Says for each oral history witness.

[4] The Early Case Planning CMC Brief shall be filed in accordance with Practice Direction #12, 10 days prior to the Early Case Planning CMC. The Registry shall also schedule a Pre-Hearing Conference for that date or just after, unless both Parties agree in writing that no such conference is required. Briefs shall be required as usual.

[5] The Early Case Planning CMC Brief need not include the lists and copies required by section 4.3 and 4.4 of Practice Direction #12. The Parties may also dispense with the requirements of section 4.1 if they both agree.
