**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable William Grist**

A first Case Management Conference (CMC) was held by teleconference on March 19, 2019, at 2:00 P.M., Eastern Time (Ottawa).

[1] The Parties agreed to bifurcate the Claim into separate phases to address validity and compensation, if necessary. The Tribunal shall issue a bifurcation Order.

[2] The Parties agreed that section 22 Notices shall be delivered to the province of British Columbia and to four other First Nations on the Saanich peninsula, the Tsartlip, Tsawout, Malahat and Pauquachin First Nations. The Tribunal shall issue such section 22 Notices.

[3] An oral history evidence hearing and site visit are anticipated to take place in August 2019 in North Saanich. The Parties shall agree on dates and advise the Tribunal before May 1, 2019. The hearing shall start on a Tuesday.

[4] The Parties shall agree on an Oral History Protocol and a Site Visit Protocol prior to the hearing. The Oral History Protocol shall require the provision of the names of and Will-Say Statements by all those who intend to give oral history testimony no less than three weeks in advance of the hearing.

[5] An Early Case Planning CMC pursuant to Practice Direction # 12 shall take place directly following the oral history evidence hearing and site visit. The oral history evidence hearing, site visit and Early Case Planning CMC may together last up to four days.

[6] The Registry shall contact the Parties to schedule a Pre-Hearing Conference once the dates for the oral history evidence hearing and site visit have been set.
